	The images and videos will be processed for publication on the websites of the MAIRE group, on the sites of third parties authorized by the Data Controller and through any other means and form of communication to the public, and other systems or technologies of remote communication, useful for the promotion of events by the Data Controller. Images and videos are also intended to document the initiative and spread it through digital communication channels, including popular social media.		Consent (optional and revocable at any time)		The photographic images and audio and video recordings will be kept in the archives of the Data Controller, in relation to their possible use for the purposes indicated, for a period of five years. After this period, the data will be permanently deleted or transformed into an anonymous form. Data not controlled by the Data Controller disseminated on the web (Facebook, You Tube, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn, corporate documents etc.) are excluded.
	For sending information material about the Data Controller’s activity (such as newsletters, brochures, event invitations) by e-mail.		Consent (optional and revocable at any time)		Until the consent is withdrawn. In case of withdrawal of consent, data will be destroyed and deleted.
Once the above retention terms have elapsed, the data will be destroyed, deleted or made anonymous.					

	DATA SUPPLY The provision of data is optional, however refusal to provide data implies the impossibility of allowing the person concerned to be made aware of the initiatives of the Foundation and to be mentioned in the related communications activities.

	CATEGORIES OF DATA RECIPIENTS <p>The Data may be communicated to external individuals/entities operating as data controllers, such as supervisory and control authorities and any public or private entities entitled to request data.</p> <p>The data may be processed, on behalf of the Data Controller, by entities designated as data processor, such as companies that organize events or support Foundation in communication activities</p>
	PARTIES AUTHORIZED FOR PROCESSING <p>The Data may be processed by employees of the Company belonging to departments responsible for the pursuit of the aforementioned purposes that have been expressly authorized for processing and have received adequate operating instructions by Data Controller or Data Processor</p>
	TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA TO COUNTRIES OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION <p>The data may be transferred to legal entities belonging to the MAIRE group or to other subjects in countries outside of Europe, pursuant to a contractual or commercial relationship or for specific business needs.</p>
	RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECT - COMPLAINTS TO THE CONTROL AUTHORITY <p>By contacting the Group Corporate Affairs Department, Governance, Ethics & Compliance Depart. via e-mail privacy@groupmaire.com the data subjects can ask the Company to have access to their data, deletion, the correction of inaccurate data, the integration of incomplete data, the limitation of processing in the cases provided for by article 18 GDPR¹, and oppose the processing carried out for legitimate interest of the controller.</p> <p>Furthermore, if processing is based on consent or on the contract and is carried out using automated tools, the data subject shall have the right to receive the Data in a structured and commonly used format that can be read on automatic devices, and, if technically feasible, to send them to another controller without impediments.</p> <p>The data subject shall have the right to refusal the consent for the processing of information material in any moment and to oppose the processing carried out for the same purposes. Nevertheless, the data subject that prefers to be contacted by non-automated means may refuse the automated communication.</p> <p>Data subjects are entitled to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.</p>

¹ The right to limitation of the processing consists in the temporary submission of the data to the storage operation only, in the following cases provided for by art. 18 GDPR:

- the accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject, for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data;
- the processing is unlawful, and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead;
- the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims;
- the data subject has objected to processing pursuant to Article 21(1) pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject.

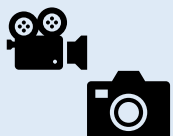
